FALL SEMESTER DATES

Teaching in the autumn semester will take place 12 September to 11 December. The examination period is 2 January to 12 February. You can find all dates for the next academic year here.

REMINDER: ENROLL AND REGISTER FOR THE UPCOMING SEMESTER

During the Summer Holidays, don't forget to enroll for the upcoming semester and register for courses using the IS. You can start applying for enrollment in the term from 16.5 to 19.9 and start registering for courses from 20.6 to 28.8

Quick Reminder - Registration and Enrollment are separate actions

- Registration: The registration period determines the interest of students in courses. Students can obtain better time stamps for capacity-limited courses.
- Enrollment: During this period there is an automatic enrollment / confirmation of subjects for which enrollment conditions have been met (capacity, prerequisites, etc.). Only at the moment of enrollment do you acquire the right and obligation to study the course.

GRADUATION

September 2022

Graduation will take place in the first week of September for students who successfully pass their final state exams and thesis defenses. Students will be provided information about the graduation during the summer. The faculty arranges virtual attendance for students unable to travel back to Brno so they can participate in the graduation ceremony.

NEW BACHELOR'S PROGRAMME APPLICATION PROCESS

There is a new application process for our bachelor's programmes. Decisions will be primarily based on an entrance exam. If you know of anyone interested in applying at FSS, please make sure you do not share too much of your own experience as the process is different. You can find the new requirements on our website.

RENEWING VISAS AND WORK VISAS

Be aware of the expiration date

Students are responsible with ensuring their residency in the Czech Republic stays active. We urge students to look at their visa or residence permit expiration dates and plan ahead.

Students should schedule their appointment in the governmental system https://frs.gov.cz/en. Often appointments are booked 1-2 months in advance and it can be hard to get last minute appointments, therefore please plan ahead!

Once an appointment is scheduled, students can use our new FSS Mates programme to attend the appointment and help with any translation problems.

Renewing your student visa/residence permit

As a reminder, you cannot submit the application to renew your study visa until 120 days before the expiration date (i.e. if it is for September 4, you earliest you can apply is May 4), however it is always good to review what you will need for the application (proof of funds, health insurance, etc.) so you can plan ahead. The required amount of funds have now increased to 102,000CZK. Please don't forget that according to the governmental decision you are allowed to use only PVZP company and it must be comprehensive health care. Other insurance won't be accepted by the MOI office for visa purposes, you can use this link to get the insurance.

Renewing your student visa/residence permit

Students who are renewing a residence permit (the plastic card) are able to submit the <u>documents</u> via registered mail (in Czech "doporučeně"). If you choose to apply via mail rather than in person, send them also "žádost o sdělení čísla jednacího" (to get your application number) and don't forget you need to send also the stamp to pay it (in Czech "kolek", you can buy it at the post office). If you have questions about this process, you can write to Klára Němečková at 217236@muni.cz and she will help advise you.

Are you graduating? 'Purpose of seeking employment' visas allows you to stay in the Czech Republic for up to 9 months to find a job and transition to a work visa.

Foreign nationals who are residing in the territory of the Czech Republic with a long-term residence permit for the purpose of studies and who successfully completed their university education are eligible to file an application for a long-term residence permit for the purpose of seeking employment or, as the case may be, an application for a long-term residence permit for the purpose of starting a business.
