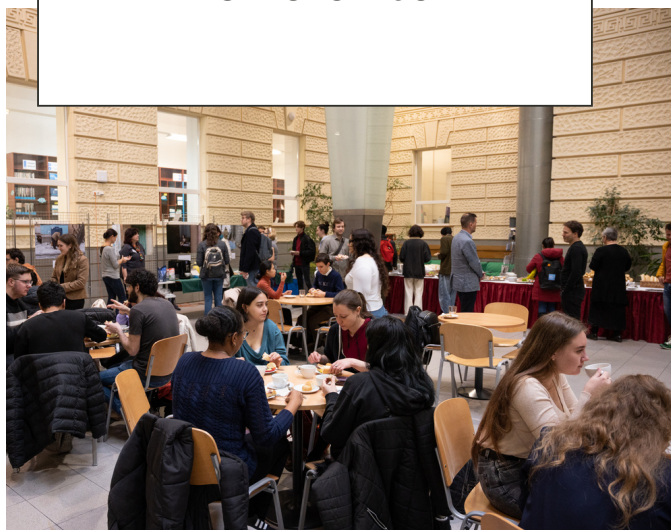
## APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS
