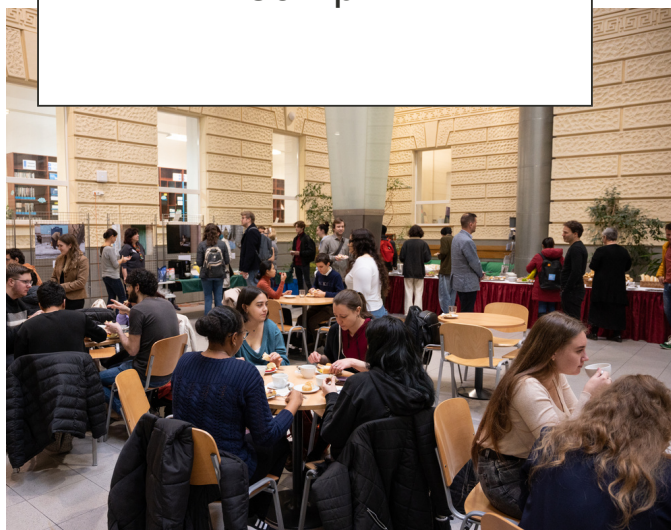
APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS
