NATIONAL HOLIDAYS IN MAY

1 May - Labour day

The Czech Republic recognizes May 1st as Labor Day, but it is also a special day known as the Day of Love.

According to ancient legends, it is customary for couples to share a kiss under a cherry tree in full bloom. Failure to do so may result in misfortune, as it is believed that a girl who is not kissed on this day will wither within a year.

In rural areas, there are village balls and decorated maypoles are erected. Meanwhile, students in cities celebrate the occasion with Majáles, a festive celebration of student life. In Brno, Majáles will take place on May 11th.

It's worth noting that shops may be closed on this public holiday.

8 May - Liberation Day

May 8th celebrates the end of WWII in Europe. Shops over 200 square meters must be closed on this day, so do your shopping beforehand!



FINAL SEMESTER CHECKLIST

- Make sure you know when you should submit your thesis. There are multiple deadlines: 80% completion, final submission, registering for you thesis defense, registering for state exam. Each department is responsible for sharing the deadlines with students, as every programme has different deadlines.
 - Start studying for your state exam definitely by the time you submit your thesis. Programmes provide literature that you should be prepared to on the exam.
- Schedule an appointment with the career centre to review your CV and help you prepare for interviews. Their website is not yet available in English, however you can schedule consultation appointments by emailing them at poradenstvi@kariera.muni.cz.
- Check your visa status make sure you know when the date expires and have your plans made. If you want to apply for the 'searching for employment' visa make sure you understand the materials you will need to do so.
 - Check your information is correct in the IS including your full name, place and country of birth and the name of the diploma thesis. This will ensure all documents get printed out correctly

GRADUATION

17, 18 and 19 September 2024

Graduation will take place 17, 18 and 19 September 2024 for students who successfully pass their final state exams and thesis defenses. Students will be provided information about the graduation during the summer. The faculty arranges virtual attendance for students unable to travel back to Brno so they can participate in the graduation ceremony.



RED DIPLOMA

What is it?

Red diplomas are awarded to students who graduate with honors. In order to be considered for this, students must meet certain requirements throughout their studies and in their final state exams. To understand the requirements, please read the study regulations, section 26 <u>here</u>.

Maintaining good grades throughout the studies is therefore necessary.

REPEATING CLASSES

only 2 chances to pass

Students only have two chances to pass a compulsory (obligatory) courses. If you fail a course twice, your studies are ended. Students are encouraged to keep this in mind when repeating classes.

If in doubt, please talk to your study department advisor.

EXAMS

Registering, and other regulations

Specifically for students in their first semester, please keep in mind that in most cases you need to sign up for your final exam for each course. If there are more dates available, you can cancel your chosen time - but be sure to do it prior to the exam, or you will be receiving a failing mark!

Students are able to retake exams in most cases, if they failed, if there are more exam times available - as such it can be beneficial to not sign up for the last spot available!

ACCOMMODATION REGISTRATION

For students currently in MU accommodation

The reservation deposit and all services associated with accommodation are to be paid for exclusively through the accounting record system <u>SUPO</u>. Student who have reserved a bed (agreed accommodation in advance) at MU halls of residence are obliged to pay the reservation deposit equal to the sum of 2000 CZK and 30times the <u>daily</u> rate of the dormitory fee. The current reservation deposit in the sum of 2000 CZK will be refund to the student's SUPO account and at the same time it will be generated the new reservation deposit in the amount of 2000 CZK and 30times of the daily rate of the dormitory fee. The reservation of a bed will be cancelled if student do not pay the new reservation deposit is due in 10 days after bed reservation. Accommodation fee is payable in current month in the term, which is set in <u>SUPO timetable</u>.

RENEWING VISAS AND WORK VISAS

Be aware of the expiration date

Students are responsible for ensuring their residency in the Czech Republic stays active. We urge students to look at their visa or residence permit expiration dates and plan ahead. Please book your appointment in advance via this link<u>https://frs.gov.cz/en</u>, appointments are very often taken for several weeks so it's not possible to book the appointment last minute. If you are not able to book the appointment, please go to the MOI office early in the morning (even before the opening hours) and be prepared that you'll wait for several hours.

It is necessary to submit an application before your current visa/resident permit expires, if you'll be even 1 day late, there is nothing to do and you'll have to leave the country and start the process from the beginning at the Czech embassy in your home country.

Once an appointment is scheduled, students can use our new <u>FSS Mates program</u> to attend the appointment and help with any translation problems.

Renewing your student visa/residence permit

As a reminder, you cannot submit the application to renew your study visa until 120 days before the expiration date (i.e. if it is for September 4, you earliest you can apply is May 4), however, it is always good to review what you will need for the application (proof of funds, health insurance, etc.) so you can plan ahead. The required amount of funds has now increased to 115,810 CZK. However, due to current inflation, we recommend having at least 120,000 CZK. Please remember that all documents are accepted only as original with stamp and signature and in the Czech language.

Renewing your student visa/residence permit

Students who are renewing a residence permit (the plastic card) are able to submit the <u>documents</u> via registered mail (in Czech "doporučeně")- during these times we urge you to use this option. Please send them also "žádost o sdělení čísla jednacího" (to get your application number) and don´t forget you need to send also the stamp to pay it (in Czech "kolek", you can buy it at the post office). If you have questions about this process, you can write to Klára Němečková at <u>217236@muni.cz</u> and she will help advise you.

Are you graduating? 'Purpose of seeking employment' visas allows you to stay in the Czech Republic for up to 9 months to find a job and transition to a work visa.

Foreign nationals who are residing in the territory of the Czech Republic with a long-term residence permit for the purpose of studies and who successfully completed their university education are eligible to file an application for a long-term residence permit for the purpose of seeking employment or, as the case may be, an application for a long-term residence permit for the purpose of starting a business. For more information on the requirements for obtaining a visa for the 'purposes of seeking employment, please visit the MOI website.

Last year we organized a presentation to discuss this visa with the Brno Expat Centre, you can see it <u>here</u>. We may offer it again and if so will inform you.

If you decide to interrupt your studies, please consider that your study visa may be terminated. Your study visa is valid only for the period in which you are an active student.

The duration of the residence permit is determined by the shortest validity period among the submitted documents. For instance, if your accommodation contract is for 6 months while the other documents cover a period of 12 months, your residence permit will be issued for 6 months only.
